ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL

EVERY DAY MATTERS AT MANNERING PARK PS.

Our goal at MPPS is 95% for every student!

If my child misses 1 day per fortnight, they miss 4 weeks per year. That's 1 year of learning missed over their entire schooling. Missing 1 day per week equals 8 weeks per year, which is 2.5 years of schooling.

HOMEWORK

READING



Reading forms the basis for every Key Learning Area. Students are encouraged to read a book, comic or magazine of their choice for at least 20 minutes every day.

MATHEMATICS

$$5+5=10$$

Daily math practice helps can help consolidate skills learnt in class. Math sheets will be provided. Additional times tables and division tables are beneficial too and can be easily written out or practiced online.

PHONICS/SPELLING



Sound Waves forms the basis for our spelling program. Weekly practice and segmenting worksheets will be provided. Sound Waves activities can also be accessed online.
