ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL

Our goal at MPPS is 95% for every student!

If my child misses 1 day per fortnight, they miss 4 weeks per year. That's 1 year of learning missed over their entiré schooling. Missing 1 day per week equals 8 weeks per year, which is 2.5 years of schooling.

READING



Reading forms the basis for every Key Learning Area. Students are encouraged to read for at least 20 minutes every day from a book of their choice.

MATHEMATICS
