

ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL

EVERY DAY MATTERS AT MANNERING PARK PS.

Our goal at MPPS is 95% for every student!

If my child misses 1 day per fortnight, they miss 4 weeks per year. That's 1 year of learning missed over their entire schooling. Missing 1 day per week equals 8 weeks per year, which is 2.5 years of schooling.

HOMEWORK

READING

Reading forms the basis for every Key Learning Area. Students are encouraged to read for at least 20 minutes every day from a book of their choice.



MATHEMATICS

Daily mathematics practice helps consolidate skills learnt in class. Additional times tables and division practice is beneficial.
