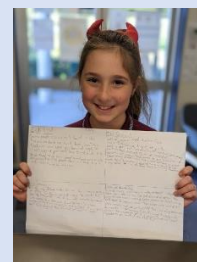

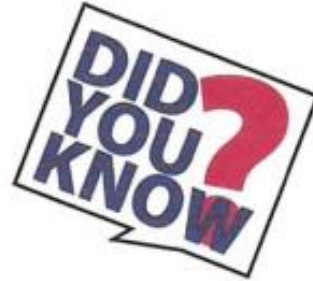
Who: All students will participate. The PBL team will analyse data and provide class lists for teachers to add student choice on Monday Week 10.
